#### **AN INVITATION**

# **SERMON OUTLINE**

# i. What kind of body will we have in the resurrection? (1 Corinthians 15:35-37)

- A. What is the human body? (Genesis 2:5-7)
  - We are body and soul psychosomatic beings (Matthew 10:28)
  - 2. Our body isn't everything, but it also isn't nothing (1 Samuel 16:7; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20)
- B. The resurrection body will be different then our present body (1 Corinthians 15:35–37)
  - 1. There is a continuity between the two bodies (John 20:19-20)
  - 2. Our present body is significant (1 Corinthians 6:14)

## ii. God gives a different yet related body in the resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:38-42a)

- A. Not all flesh is the same (1 Corinthians 15:38-41)
- B. The resurrection body is similar to the natural cycle (1 Corinthians 15:42a)
  - One day these present bodies will perish (2 Corinthians 4:16-18)
  - 2. But we will receive glorious resurrection bodies (2 Corinthians 5:1-5)
- C. The Spirit is our guarantee of resurrection (2 Corinthians 5:5; Ephesians 4:30; Romans 8:23-25)

# iii. The Resurrection Body Will Be Like Jesus' (1 Corinthians 15:42-49)

- A. Our current body bears the image of the man of dust (1 Corinthians 15:42-49)
- B. Our resurrection body will bear the image of the man of heaven (1 Corinthians 15:42-49)
  - These lowly bodies will be like his glorious body (Philippians 3:20-21)
  - 2. When we die, we are planted not buried, we will rise to untarnished glory!
- C. In the meantime, we seek to glorify God with our bodies  $\mbox{\bf (2)}$

#### Corinthians 5:8-10)

- 1. Do not offer your body to sin (Romans 6:12-13)
- 2. Rather present your body vs God's instrument for glory (Romans 12:1)
